Dr Yang Ching Yu, Medical Director, Raffles China Healthcare Division

Dr Yang Ching Yu joined **RafflesMedicalGroup** in 1993 when Raffles Surgicentre opened, and he has been with the Group for over 25 years. Dr Yang has been a Medical Director of **RafflesHospital Singapore** since 2001. Concurrently, he is also the Medical Director for **RafflesHospital Chongqing** since its opening in January 2019.

Dr Yang received his MBBS in 1980 from the University of Singapore. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons (Glasgow) (1986) and the Academy of Medicine Singapore 1992. Dr Yang underwent advance specialist training at The Cleveland Clinic, Ohio USA, where he was a special Fellow in the Department of Colorectal Surgery and Gastro-Intestinal Surgery under a Singapore Government Health Manpower Development Plan Scholarship in 1989. Besides general surgery procedures, Dr Yang is particularly interested in colorectal surgery, sphincter preserving rectal procedures, complicated recto-anal fistula surgeries and has extensive diagnostic & therapeutic endoscopy experience. He has been actively pursuing minimally invasive laparoscopic procedures since 1990. In July 2003, Dr Yang was the lead surgeon involved in the successful separation of the Korean Ischio-pagus conjoined twins at **RafflesHospital**.

Dr Vincent Chia, Deputy Managing Director, Raffles China Healthcare Division

Prior to joining **RafflesMedicalGroup**, Dr Chia was the founder and Medical Director of Asian Healthcare Solutions. He has worked as an independent healthcare consultant from 2017 to end 2019, and covered strategy, quality and operational projects in China and South East Asia.
